who has been exposed to someone with COVID19 within the last 14 days;
who has a temperature over 100.4 degrees; who has a new or worsening cough,
difficulty breathing, body aches, sore throat, changes in taste or smell; or has
recently traveled outside of the country.**

PUBLIC

- ENTRANCE: **Enter at the North door**
- The public is highly encouraged to call ahead so paperwork can be started in the office.
- The public is encouraged to continue handling business by the mail, email, fax, drop box or telephone.
- Limited members of the public will be allowed in the building based on office capacity.
- You are strongly encouraged to wear face coverings.
- Adhere to minimum social distancing guideline of 6 foot
- Water Fountains will be closed
- Limited restroom use
- Members of the public who will not observe safety provisions will be asked to conduct their business by mail, email, fax, drop box or telephone.
