

DIXON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS PROCEEDINGS – February 16, 2023

The Dixon County Board of Supervisors met on February 16, 2023 at 6:00 P.M. for a Special meeting at the Ponca Community Center, 119 W 3rd Street, Ponca, Nebraska. Chair Lisa Lunz led the Pledge of Allegiance, then called for roll call of members present. Answering were: Don Andersen, Neil Blohm, Terry Nicholson, Steve Hassler, Roger Peterson, Deric Anderson, and Lisa Lunz. Absent: None. Also present was Cindy Purucker, Dixon County Clerk and Secretary to the Board. Chair Lunz gave notice to the public of the location of the posted Open Meetings Law.
