

**DIXON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS PROCEEDINGS**

The Dixon County Board of Supervisors met on December 10, 2024, at 9:00 A.M. for an adjourned meeting at the Dixon County Annex Building in Ponca, Nebraska. Acting Chairperson Neil Blohm opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance and called for roll call of members present. Answering were: Don Andersen, Terry Nicholson, Steve Hassler, Roger Peterson, Deric Anderson and Neil Blohm. Absent: Lisa Lunz. Also present were Cathy Stilwell, Dixon County Clerk and Secretary to the Board of Supervisors, and other interested persons. Chair Blohm gave notice to the public of the location of the posted Open Meetings Law.

Motion was made by Andersen, seconded by Peterson to show that this meeting was preceded by due and legal notice by posting as required by law in the Bank of Dixon County, bulletin board in the lower hall of the courthouse, bulletin board in the County Clerk's office and two County newspapers, and all Board Members were notified simultaneously and the agenda of all known business to come before the Board of Supervisors was posted in the office of the County Clerk. On roll call vote, Motion carried. Supervisors voting in favor of said motion were: Don Andersen, Neil Blohm, Steve Hassler, Terry Nicholson, Roger Peterson, Deric Anderson, Supervisors voting against: None. Absent: Lunz.

Motion was made by Nicholson, seconded by Hassler, to approve the minutes of the last meeting as written. On roll call vote, Motion carried. Supervisors voting in favor of said motion were: Don Andersen, Neil Blohm, Steve Hassler, Terry Nicholson, Roger Peterson, Deric Anderson, Supervisors voting against: None. Absent: Lunz.

Engineer, Brian McDonald and part-time Road Supt., Arnold Mellick present to discuss ongoing road and bridge projects.

Discussion took place on minimum maintenance roads and building on minimum maintenance roads. It was decided it would be the Dixon County Board's decision whether a minimum maintenance road would be upgraded or remain a minimum maintenance road. Several roads were discussed that need to be closed for liability reasons. There are several roads in the county that have fencing or gates over roads that need to be removed if the road is not officially closed by the County and Township.

Motion by Peterson, seconded by Anderson to approve chair to sign payment application No: 2 for the Ponca West project. On roll call Motion carried. Supervisors voting in favor of said motion were: Don Andersen, Neil Blohm, Steve Hassler, Terry Nicholson, Roger Peterson, Deric Anderson, Supervisors voting against: None. Absent: Lunz.

After discussion a motion was made by Anderson to have chair sign the Nebraska DOT agreement and resolution to temporarily close 586<sup>th</sup> Ave at the intersection with Highway 12 to accommodate repairs to the bridge as part of the Highway Improvement Project, Newcastle-Ponca N-12. Seconded by Peterson. On roll call vote Motion carried. Supervisors voting in favor of said motion were: Don Andersen, Neil Blohm, Steve Hassler, Terry Nicholson, Roger Peterson, Deric Anderson, Supervisors voting against: None. Absent: Lunz. Closure of the road between highway 15 and 580 road in Hooker township was tabled until January with a motion by Peterson, seconded by Anderson. On roll call vote Motion carried. Supervisors voting in favor of said motion were: Don Andersen, Neil Blohm, Steve Hassler, Terry Nicholson, Roger Peterson, Deric Anderson, Supervisors voting against: None. Absent: Lunz.

Motion by Nicholson and seconded by Peterson to have chair sign the resolution to close the portion of 580<sup>th</sup> Ave, a one-mile portion of road between Hwy 20 and 871 Rd in Clark Township. The West ½ of Section 26 and the East ½ of Section 27 of Township 29 Range 4E. On roll call vote Motion carried. Supervisors voting in favor of said motion were: Don Andersen, Neil Blohm, Steve Hassler, Terry Nicholson, Roger Peterson, Deric Anderson, Supervisors voting against: None. Absent: Lunz. Brian McDonald was appointed as the Dixon County's Highway Superintendent Starting Jan 2025, for a salary of \$100.00 per month, on a motion by Nicholson and second by Hassler. On roll call vote, Motion carried. Supervisors voting in favor of said motion were: Don Andersen, Neil Blohm, Steve Hassler, Terry Nicholson, Roger Peterson, Deric Anderson, Supervisors voting against: None. Absent: Lunz.

The 2025 Printing Schedule was approved on a motion by Peterson, seconded by Hassler. On roll call vote, Motion carried. Supervisors voting in favor of said motion were: Don Andersen, Neil Blohm, Steve Hassler, Terry Nicholson, Roger Peterson, Deric Anderson, Supervisors voting against: None. Applications for County Depositories for 2025 were reviewed. Motion was made by Peterson, seconded by Nicholson to adopt resolutions approving the Bank of Dixon County, Ponca, NE, First Nebraska Bank, Valley, NE, Security Bank, Laurel, NE and Nebraska Public Agency Investment Trust (NPAIT), Lincoln, NE as County Depositories for 2025. On roll call vote, Motion carried. Supervisors voting in favor of said motion were: Don Andersen, Neil Blohm, Steve Hassler, Terry Nicholson, Roger

Peterson, Deric Anderson, Supervisors voting against: None. Absent: Lunz. Resolution in **Resolution & Ordinances Book 3, Pages 476-493.**

Shea Scollard, Emergency Manager updates, he has been working with the NDOT with corrections. Grant audit reports are due. Last Thursday a truck damaged the culvert in the driveway at the Annex Building. Sara Kumm, 911 Coordinator and Sheriff Tom Decker went to check on the towers and there is a door handle that needs to be replaced.

Due to problems with icy roads this morning, and the state trucks not being there, County Road Crew and sand trucks had to be dispatched. The 911 Coordinator suggested getting a radio in the sand truck so 911 can contact the County Road Crew directly if this situation happens in the future.

Sara presented pictures of the Courthouse roof from a drone, she pin pointed areas where the leaking is still occurring, these are areas we thought were fixed.

Motion by Hassler to allow E911 Department to dispose of items on inventory, seconded by Anderson. On roll call vote, Motion carried. Supervisors voting in favor of said motion were: Don Andersen, Neil Blohm, Steve Hassler, Terry Nicholson, Roger Peterson, Deric Anderson, Supervisors voting against: None. Absent: Lunz.

On a motion by Anderson and second by Andersen to appoint Shea Scollard as Emergency Manager and Sara Kumm as 911 Director for 2025. On roll call vote, Motion carried. On roll call vote, Motion carried. The Board recessed to meet as Board of Equalization, and reconvened with all members present.
