The Dixon County Board of Supervisors met on September 9, 2025, at 9:00 A.M. for an adjourned meeting at the Dixon County Annex Building in Ponca, Nebraska. Chair Lisa Lunz opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance and called for roll call of members present. Answering were: Don Andersen, Terry Nicholson, Steve Hassler, Roger Peterson, Deric Anderson and Lisa Lunz. Absent: Neil Blohm. Also, present were Cathy Stilwell, Dixon County Clerk and Secretary to the Board of Supervisors and other interested persons.
