

DIXON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS PROCEEDINGS

The Dixon County Board of Supervisors met on July 14, 2026, at 9:00 A.M. for an adjourned meeting at the Dixon County Annex Building at 59140 Hwy 12 in Ponca, Nebraska. Chair Lisa Lunz opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance and called for roll call of members present. Answering was: Don Andersen, Neil Blohm, Terry Nicholson, Steve Hassler, Roger Peterson, Deric Anderson, and Lisa Lunz. Absent: None. Also present were Cathy Stilwell, Dixon County Clerk and Secretary to the Board of Supervisors and other interested persons. Chair Lunz gave notice to the public of the location of the posted Open Meetings Law.

Motion was made by Blohm, seconded by Andersen to show that this meeting was preceded by due and legal notice by posting as required by law in the Bank of Dixon County, bulletin board in the lower hall of the courthouse, bulletin board in the County Clerk's office and two County newspapers, and all Board Members were notified simultaneously and the agenda of all known business to come before the Board of Supervisors was posted in the office of the County Clerk. On roll call vote, Motion carried. Supervisors voting in favor of said motion were: Don Andersen, Neil Blohm, Steve Hassler, Terry Nicholson, Roger Peterson, Deric Anderson, and Lisa Lunz. Absent: None. Supervisors voting against: None.

Motion was made by Andersen, seconded by Hassler to approve the minutes of the last meeting as written. On roll call vote, Motion carried. Supervisors voting in favor of said motion were: Don Andersen, Neil Blohm, Steve Hassler, Terry Nicholson, Roger Peterson, Deric Anderson, and Lisa Lunz. Absent: None. County Attorney, Leland Miner meet with the board on Legal matters. The City of Wakefield Contract for the Sheriff's office needs updated. Sheriff Decker and Attorney Miner will be working together to get new agreement.

Motion by Nicholson to authorize Chair Lunz to sign the Purchase Agreement with J21 Land & Cattle Company. Seconded by Blohm. On roll call vote, Motion carried. Supervisors voting in favor of said motion were: Don Andersen, Neil Blohm, Steve Hassler, Terry Nicholson, Roger Peterson, Deric Anderson, and Lisa Lunz. Absent: None. Discussed a Lease agreement for the Newcastle Tower site.

Discussed an easement for the City of Ponca, Travis Orlander was present. Referencing: All portions of West Street, as plotted, lying between the southern boundary of W. Third Street, as plotted, in accordance with State Law Statute 18-1716.01 Any city or village annexing property contiguous to or abutting upon any part of a county road shall be deemed to have annexed, without further action, all of the continuous or abutting road at the time of such annexation, except that this section shall not apply to county roads separating counties. After discussion, no easement agreement is needed.

In the process of switching insurance companies the board reviewed and discussed the Run-Out Claims Administration Agreement with Point-C, a motion was made by Andersen, seconded by Hassler to sign the agreement. On roll call vote, Motion carried. Supervisors voting in favor of said motion were: Don Andersen, Neil Blohm, Steve Hassler, Terry Nicholson, Roger Peterson, Deric Anderson, and Lisa Lunz. After discussing the Local Political Subdivision Acquisition Contract for Arnold and Phyllis Getz it was tabled due to missing information for the easement.

Engineer & PT Road Supt. Brian McDonald was present to discuss ongoing road and bridge projects. Lunz stated the Allen North Project one year warranty will be up August 13, 2026 and the 861 and 588 Improvements Project one year warranty will be up July 29, 2026.

Motion by Hassler to authorize chair Lunz to sign contracts to award the Bid of the Waterbury South Project to JMN Construction of Valley, NE. Seconded by Blohm. On roll call vote, Motion carried. Motion by Anderson to Authorize the County Clerk to Advertise for bids on the Highway 12 Intersection East of Newcastle. Seconded by Hassler. On roll call vote, Motion carried. Supervisors voting in

Discussed and made improvements to the one & Six Plan for Roads and Bridges.

With McDonald the board discussed getting an improved utility permit application to include insurance and bonding.

Blohm made motion to offer the remaining North portion of 576 Ave (Cedar Co Line) between 884 & 886 Roads to Hooker Township. The South position was partially closed in April 2026 seconded by Anderson. On roll call vote, Motion carried. At 10:00 A.M. BVH architecture gave updates in person and by Zoom. Reviewed Master Planning Schedule, ten companies sent courthouse proposals, four were interviewed, and one was picked after the interviews were discussed by the Ad Hoc committee. A motion by Hassler and seconded by Lunz to approve the construction manager at risk to Sampson Construction. On roll call vote, Motion carried. Thank you to Dakota County for letting he use their road signs for the Ponca Rodeo, so people were notified of traffic ahead. Talked about doing classes for babysitters, how to make a 911 call, questions that would be asked and have a CPR class. For August he will be getting together with JEO to get a proposal for the comprehensive plan.

Tom Decker, the County Sheriff, presented the board with the inspections that were completed for the towers and a proposal with Tower Systems, Inc. to do the repairs that are required per NIRMA

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inspections. Motion by Blohm to have Chair Lunz sign the contract, seconded by Hassler. On roll call vote, Motion carried.
